

Fort Stanton LIVE Lecture Series:

- **Fort Stanton Cave:** Presented by the BLM and the Fort Stanton Cave Study Project, this lecture focuses on the third-longest cave in the state and the discovery of the Snowy River passage.
- **The Lincoln Conspiracy & Fort Stanton:** Did you know that 4 of the 12 convicted conspirators behind the assassination of Abraham Lincoln were stationed at Fort Stanton? Learn all about it at this presentation by William F. Haenn.
- **Confinement in the Land of Enchantment: Japanese Internment at Fort Stanton:** This presentation chronicles the experiences of Japanese Americans who lived in New Mexico just before, during and after World War II. Presented by the CLOE Project. After several months at Fort Stanton, this exhibit will travel on to Lordsburg and Santa Fe.
- **Washed Ashore: Treating Consumptive Sailors in New Mexico** presented by Nancy Owen Lewis, author of *“Chasing the Cure in New Mexico”*. In 1899, Fort Stanton would become the first federal sanatorium for the treatment of tuberculosis. Its contributions to the medical profession as well as its impact on the local community and statehood are emphasized in this illustrated presentation.
